## Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is an approach to religious formation for children ages 3-12. It developed in Rome with the collaboration of two women: Sofia Cavalletti, a Hebrew Scripture Scholar, and Gianna Gobbi, a Montessori instructor. Over many years they observed children's reaction to scripture and liturgy and Catechesis of the Good Shepherd was born. This is a "hands-on" approach for passing on the faith. The children gather in a sacred space called an atrium. The room is designed with the child in mind centered on simplicity, order, prayer, work and community. Together with the catechist we hear, ponder and celebrate the mysteries of the Christian faith revealed through scripture and liturgy. This method is practiced internationally by many Christian schools.
