## Sex Education in the Hawaii State Department of Education (Public Schools)

On June 16, 2015, the Hawaii Board of Education voted to make sexual education mandatory in all public schools. Since Catholic parents are entrusted, from the moment of their child's baptism, with the role of being the primary educators in matters of faith, including the Church's teachings on chastity and human sexuality, it is best to examine these issues in the light of Catholic teachings.

Therefore, the Diocese of Honolulu **strongly urges** parents to:

- Pray with your spouse, pastor, or close friend. Call upon the Holy Spirit for wisdom, understanding, and strength.
- Examine the human sexuality curriculum at your child's school to gain a good understanding of what your child will learn.
- Discuss your values with your child in a loving, nurturing and age-appropriate way.
- Calmly and in a positive manner, discuss and correct attitudes being taught in the school's human sexuality curriculum that do not align with the values of your family and the Church. If necessary, exercise your right to opt out your child from the human sexuality curriculum.
