*Our Lady Queen of Angels (1940), was the second church built in Kula following Holy Ghost Church (1899) and St. James the Less (1950).

*OLQA parishioner Maile Morreira (grandfather: Joseph Shim) descends from the upcountry Chinatown Shim family that helped build the Kula pipeline for much needed water.



*Some at Holy Ghost say the statue of the saint with the cute pig is there because they are a farming community. Might this be St. Anthony the Great, the founder of monasticism, patron and protector of animals?

*Travelers to the earliest Holy Ghost feastday celebrations arrived from Lahaina and beyond on horseback. The church began the tradition of feeding the wayfarers with laulau and more. Willie Jacinta and family continue to donate a couple of cows to the annual feast. Granddaughter Katie Jacinta plays ukulele at OLQA. She is also the niece of Father Michael Owens.
