


SIGN OF THE CROSS & GREETING


PENITENTIAL ACT



RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

Bishop: A: Do you renounce Satan?


Or B: Do you renounce sin, so as to live in the freedom of the children of God?

- ALL: I do. Bishop: A: And all his empty show? Or B: Do you renounce Satan, the author and prince of sin? ALL: I do. Bishop: Do you believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth? ALL: I do. Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, Bishop: who was born of the Virgin Mary, suffered death and was buried, rose again from the dead. and is seated at the right hand of the Father? ALL: I do. Bishop: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting? ALL: I do. Bishop: And may almighty God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given us new birth by water and the Holy Spirit and bestowed on us forgiveness of our sins,

keep us by his grace, in Christ Jesus our Lord, for eternal life.



Bishop: Deliver us, Lord, ... the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ. People:



- **People:** And with your spirit.






