John Burland is an educator, speaker and composer who has been writing and recording music for children and adults for over twenty-five years. He has published sixteen music collections which are used extensively in school/parish communities across Australia, New Zealand, the United States, the United Kingdom, and Canada. John is currently the Education Officer: Archdiocesan Liturgical Music for Sydney Catholic Schools. In this role John works with children, families, and educators in promoting catechesis and evangelization through song, movement, prayer, and story. Over the last twenty years John has been a regular presenter at the Los Angeles Religious Education Congress and the National Catholic Educational Association (NCEA) Convention in the United States.
