

THEME: "Mission of Aloha"

### ART GUIDELINES:

- 1. Size: 8½ x 11 OR 12" x 18"
- 2. No Lettering your art carries the message
- 3. Medium: Crayon, markers, ink, paints (watercolor, acrylic, oil), charcoal, pencil (black or colored), pastels (chalk). May use canvas or drawing paper.
- 4. Entries should not be folded or rolled.
- 5. Submissions at the Diocesan Level will be scored on application and interpretation of the theme, neatness, presentation, creativity and effort.

### **GENERAL RULES:**

- 1. Contestants may enter only once. Entries not conforming to the rules will be disqualified.
- 2. All contest submissions become the property of the Diocese of Honolulu and Hawaii Catholic School Department with the right to display/and or publish any or all material.
- 3. Decisions of the judges will be final. Judges reserve the right to make no award in a Division.
- 4. Each parish/school entry sent to the diocesan level must be accompanied by a 2025 Entry Form properly signed and completed. Names must be legible. Forms must be taped to back of entry.
- 5. Plagiarism is grounds for disqualification from contest. Commercial entries will be disqualified.
- 6. Awards will be provided to Diocesan 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each of four levels (K-2, 3-5; 6-8; 9-12)
- 7. Parish/Schools will conduct their own local contest and forward their top winner in each division to the Hawaii Catholic Schools Office.
  - Parish/Schools are encouraged to celebrate at the local level with prizes and displaying of student work.
  - Parish/Schools are encouraged to gain support from parents or local businesses for local prizes
  - Parish/Schools are encouraged to post local and diocesan winners on their website
- 8. Prizes consist of:  $1^{st}$  Place = \$200.00,  $2^{nd}$  Place = \$100.00,  $3^{rd}$  Place = \$50.00

#### TIMELINE:

- September students learn about Mission of Aloha and create pieces of art;
  Parish/Schools can invite Fr. Lane Akiona, sscc; Fr. Herman Gomes, sscc; or Deacon Keith Cabiles to speak to your students about this celebration at this time,
  Parish/Schools choose diocesan submissions.
- November 6, 2025, 5pm deadline for Parish/Schools to submit to Hawaii Catholic Schools office.
- November 10-21, 2025 judging at Diocesan Level
- December 5, 2025 winners announced
