A Process for Selecting New Pastoral Council Members

Parish Education

 - A body that is advisory to the pastor,
 - That listens to the parish,
 - That creates a pastoral plan of action,
 - That invites others to help carry out that plan
 - That assists parishioners with implementation through resources and evaluation.
- 2. Invite parishioners to nominate people they think have the qualities needed by a council member:
 - Prayerful
 - Ability to listen
 - A sense of understanding where the church is today
 - Understands or is willing to learn about the Mission of the Church and the Diocese
 - Enthusiastic about the future of this parish
 - Willing and able to make the commitment to this ministry
- 3. Invite all nominees to two evenings or Saturday discernment sessions using the suggestions for education and reflection on the following pages.
